Appointee must be eligible for and maintain eligibility for full and unconditional participation in Medicaid and Medicare programs and must maintain eligibility after appointment.</p> <p>Appropriate certification by an American Medical Specialty Board and one year of post certification experience in that specialty can be substituted for four years of general experience.</p>
PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS	Board certification in Geriatric Medicine and/or Certification as a Medical Director (AMDA), and experience in a long term care facility. Understanding and commitment to the Home's core values and philosophy that residents come first is also a criterion for selection.
